- At least one parent/guardian must remain on the church premises while children are attending First Unitarian church programs. Otherwise, the Director must be notified in writing with relevant contact information.
- Parent/Guardian grants permission for any children listed on this form, 3 years old and over, to leave the church building/premises under the supervision of his/her Small Group program teacher(s), and without prior notice in each case, for nearby walking trips and related activities during the Sunday morning Spiritual Pathways program. Separate permission forms will be issued for all other trips. This consent is in effect through June, 2020. **Policies and Program Information**

- Parents must pick up children in grades 2-4.
- Young people in Grades 5 and older may leave the classroom unaccompanied at noon.
